## This Week's Parashah

Bereishit-where it all begins. On the First Day, God creates Day and Night. On the Second Day, God creates The Heavensdividing the upper and lower waters. The Third Day sees the birth of the earth, seas, plants, trees, and vegetation. On the Fourth Day. God creates the sun, moon, and stars; and on the Fifth - fish, water creatures, and birds. On the Sixth Day, animals, and Adam and Eve. On the Seventh Dav -God rests. Adam and Eve live in the Garden of Eden and God commands Adam not to eat from the Tree of Knowledge of Good & Evil. However, a serpent in the garden persuades Eve to eat the fruit from this prohibited tree. Eve then gives Adam the fruit to eat. Adam and Eve, and all people who follow, are then punished for disobeving God's one and only commandment. Adam and Eve have two sons: Cain and Abel. The brothers bring offerings to God. Abel's offering is accepted, but Cain's is not. A jealous Cain kills Abel, and responds to God's inquiry. "Am I my brother's keeper?" God expresses dismay at the evil humanity has perpetrated, promising to blot out everything created. Noah, however, finds favor with God.

# Today's Haftarah

This Haftarah, taken from the book of the prophet Isaiah, addresses the exiles living in Babylon after the destruction of the first Temple in Jerusalem. Isaiah proclaims the absolute sovereignty of God. God created the earth and formed Man. "Fear not, for I am with you; from the east will I bring your offspring, and from the west will I gather you; I shall say to the north, 'Give back,' and to the south, 'Do not withhold, bring My sons from afar and My daughters from the end of the earth." God's words affirm that God is the master of history, and that it is in God's power to redeem the people of Israel. The first sentence of the Haftarah connects it with the Torah reading of the Creation. Just as the words of Bereishit represent the beginning of the world, the Torah, and the story of life itself, so does Isaiah's message of redemption mark a new beginning for the people in exile.
