Genesis 49:3-7:

- <sup>3</sup> "Reuben, you are my firstborn,  
my might, and the firstfruits of my strength,  
preeminent in dignity and preeminent in power.  
<sup>4</sup> Unstable as water, you shall not have preeminence,  
because you went up to your father's bed;  
then you defiled it—he went up to my couch!
- <sup>5</sup> "Simeon and Levi are brothers;  
weapons of violence are their swords.  
<sup>6</sup> Let my soul come not into their council;  
O my glory, be not joined to their company.  
For in their anger they killed men,  
and in their willfulness they hamstringed oxen.  
<sup>7</sup> Cursed be their anger, for it is fierce,  
and their wrath, for it is cruel!

I will divide them in Jacob  
and scatter them in Israel.

<sup>22</sup> He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth. <sup>23</sup> When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly. <sup>24</sup> He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness.
