We are so looking forward to spending the High Holidays with all of you this year. Our commitment to you is to create a spiritually enriching experience for our entire community. We want to share with you our passion for prayer by offering many ways to be together as a congregation and as families.

This year children of all ages are welcome to attend all services with their parents. A Family Interactive service for children in 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grades will be offered on the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. There will be two seatings for families with young children, birth through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, at the Northbrook Leisure Center on the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur and one on the second day of Rosh Hashanah at CBS. In addition to our Tashlich Service at the park next to Wood Oaks on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Rosh Hashanah, we will be offering a Family Tashlich program at Congregation Beth Shalom preceding our Tashlich Service.

This High Holiday brochure includes information about our offerings for the Interactive Family services for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. While these services will be shorter than our normal High Holiday services, we can promise you that halachically, they will include everything required and more.

We will continue to offer our enhanced live streaming for all services occurring in the Kamensky Sanctuary. We invite our members who are more comfortable with this choice or unable to physically attend, to join us online and let us help make your home a sacred space.

## EVERYTHING YOU WANT TO KNOW ABOUT THE HIGH HOLIDAYS AT CBS THIS YEAR!

**Q: Where will the Clergy be conducting services?**

A: Rabbi Melman, Cantor Stoeher and Rabbi Chapman together with Cantor Meital will all be participating in our various services throughout the High Holidays, so whichever service you attend you will get to pray with all of our clergy. Erev Rosh Hashanah, the Second Day of Rosh Hashanah, and Kol Nidre, all of the clergy will be together in the Kamensky Sanctuary.



**Q: Are there Youth Services for the High Holidays?**

A: Congregation Beth Shalom will be having several High Holiday family services. The Family Interactive Service is for families to enjoy together and designed for families with children in grades 3 through 6 and will be held in the Gloss Youth Lounge. The Families With Young Children Service is for families to enjoy together and designed for families with children from birth through grade 2 (see page 3 for times and locations). **RSVP required.** There will also be a Family Tashlich Program on Rosh Hashanah Day 2 at CBS. We are really looking forward to celebrating the High Holidays with your family! Children of all ages are welcome in any service with their parents.

All strollers must be parked in the Winter Garden for safety reasons.

**Q: When will Yizkor take place?**

A: On Yom Kippur Day, Monday, September 25th, the Yizkor Service will take place at the conclusion of the Musaf service, but not before 1:00 p.m.

Our Yizkor Memorial Tribute will be streaming in our lobby and available on our [High Holiday website](#). [Submissions](#) for the CBS Yizkor Memorial Book and Memorial Tributes are due no later than **Monday, August, 14th**.

**Q: My adult children are visiting for the holidays this year. Can I buy guest tickets so they can attend services with me?**

A: Yes! Guest tickets are available for purchase for \$300 per guest. Submit the [Online Guest Ticket Form](#) or complete the form on page 6. If your adult children are members of another synagogue, they qualify for "Reciprocity" tickets. Please contact Maria Catezone at [MCatezone@BethShalomNB.org](mailto:MCatezone@BethShalomNB.org) by **Friday, September 8th** to arrange for reciprocity.

**Q: Will we be having an early and late service this year?**

A: We will only have one service this year in the Kamensky Sanctuary but we will be offering two other options for families. The Family Interactive Service is for families to enjoy together and designed for families with children in grades 3 through 6 and will be held in the Gloss Youth Lounge. The Families With Young Children Service is for families to enjoy together and designed for families with children from birth through grade 2 (see page 3 for times and locations). **There will be no Parallel service and no services at Wood Oaks Junior High.**

**Q: I have an Illinois Handicap license plate/placard. Will there be reserved parking for me?**

A: We will have a limited number of accessible spaces. We recommend arriving when the lots open for an easier time navigating your way into the building. We will have parking attendants on-site to assist you in finding parking.

If you have difficulty walking long distances, you may prefer to have a loved one drop you off near the front door before securing a parking spot for themselves.

**Q: Will the High Holiday services be live streamed? Will they be restricted for CBS members only?**

A: Yes, all of our High Holiday services that take place from the Kamensky Sanctuary will be live streamed as well as our Mincha/Ma'ariv services from the Feather Beit Midrash. High Holiday services are a benefit of your CBS membership and therefore we will send out a password for the live streaming approximately one week before the holidays.

**Q: My husband wants to arrive early to save a few seats for our family, and then I will come a bit later. Can we get two parking passes?**

A: There will be no parking passes provided by CBS this year, but parking during the holidays is always a challenge. We ask that you carpool, walk, or drive only one car per household to the synagogue. The lot will open **30 minutes** before the start time of services. Northbrook allows street parking in the neighborhoods; please be kind and do not block driveways.

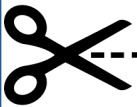
## Engaging with our Inner Prayers on Yom Kippur

Every year Jews gather to wrestle with our inner selves and to consider how it is that we might approach the New Year. One wishing to connect with God on this auspicious day offers words of tradition but can also offer words of one's conscience and heart.

When people travel to Israel it is common for them to visit the Kotel, the Western Wall, and it is quite normal that they place a *kvitel*, a small piece of paper on which one pens a petitionary prayer, in a crevice of the Kotel as a "note to God". We wish to invite **every member of CBS** to do likewise for the High Holidays this year.

This personal act of 'letter writing to God' is an added gesture of petition which enhances one's opportunity to reach out to God in a new way. Please complete your personal note either [online](#) or the one attached here by **Friday, September 22nd**, which we will then place in the Ark. These notes shall remain in the Ark until after the holiday of Sukkot, when one's complete Judgment by God is said to be finalized. After that time we will respectfully encase these notes in a container and bury them in our CBS Genizah outside of the Winter Garden. During the season of repentance, we are called upon to do T'shuvah to return to God in sincerity and truth. Through prayer and in study, reflection and ritual, we strive to begin the new year in the spirit of humility. For Tashlich, we come to a body of water into which we symbolically cast our sins. Generally this is done by throwing bread crumbs or seeds into the water as a tangible representation of our desire to be cleansed of our wrongdoings, to send away our unworthy thoughts and purify our hearts. Schach is used to cover the top of a Sukkah. According to our tradition, the roof of a Sukkah should consist of branches of trees, detached from the trunk, sparsely spread over so that the stars may be seen through them.

Each bundle of Schach is **\$25.00** and **must be pre-ordered**. The average Sukkah uses approximately five bundles. 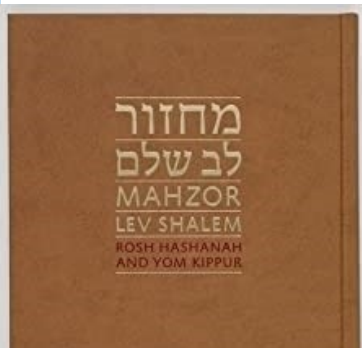


## Yizkor Memorial Photos
