



From Ukraine to Israel: Helping Refugees and Delivering Humanitarian Aid

Jeff lives in Northbrook, IL and is a volunteer first responder with the Northbrook Fire Department Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), in addition to being a member of CBS. In March of 2022, at the beginning of the Russian war against Ukraine, Jeff stepped up to help and organized a humanitarian mission to Berlin to assist Ukrainians who were fleeing the war. Most of these refugees were women and children who fled for days or weeks to escape Russian bombings and terror.

Upon returning home, Jeff founded Project Aid & Rescue, Inc. ("PAR"), a grassroots volunteer 501c3 charity organization based in Northbrook, whose purpose is to provide humanitarian aid in the form of medical supplies, food, and evacuation support to people in need. Through September 2023, this aid had been primarily focused on Ukraine.

After the Hamas terrorist attacks on Israel on October 7th, Jeff and PAR have shifted their focus to supporting the needs of Israel as they prosecute the war against Hamas. Since less than a week into the war, PAR has been working with Israel's Ministry of Health (MOH) and their Emergency and Disaster Management Team to identify and source critical care medical equipment and supplies throughout Israel.
